Preface

The XXI International School on Physics of Semiconducting Compounds "Jaszowiec 1992" was held in the *GWAREK* and *KOLEJARZ* hotels in Jaszowiec between the 22nd and the 29th of May, 1992, and was organized by the Institute of Physics, Polish Academy of Sciences and by the Faculty of Physics of Warsaw University.
