## Preface

The IV International Seminar on Highly Conducting Organic Materials for Molecular Electronics was held in Zajęczkowo near Poznań, September 20–25, 1994. The Seminar was organized by the Institute of Molecular Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences. The IV International Seminar in Zajęczkowo follows Polish–French (Czerniejewo 1985, Nancy 1987, Czerniejewo 1989) and Polish–Soviet (Czerniejewo 1988, Chernogolovka 1990, Kiekrz 1992) Seminars on related subjects. The purpose of the present meeting was to bring together outstanding specialists and young scientists working in the field of organic conducting materials, which can find application in molecular electronics.
